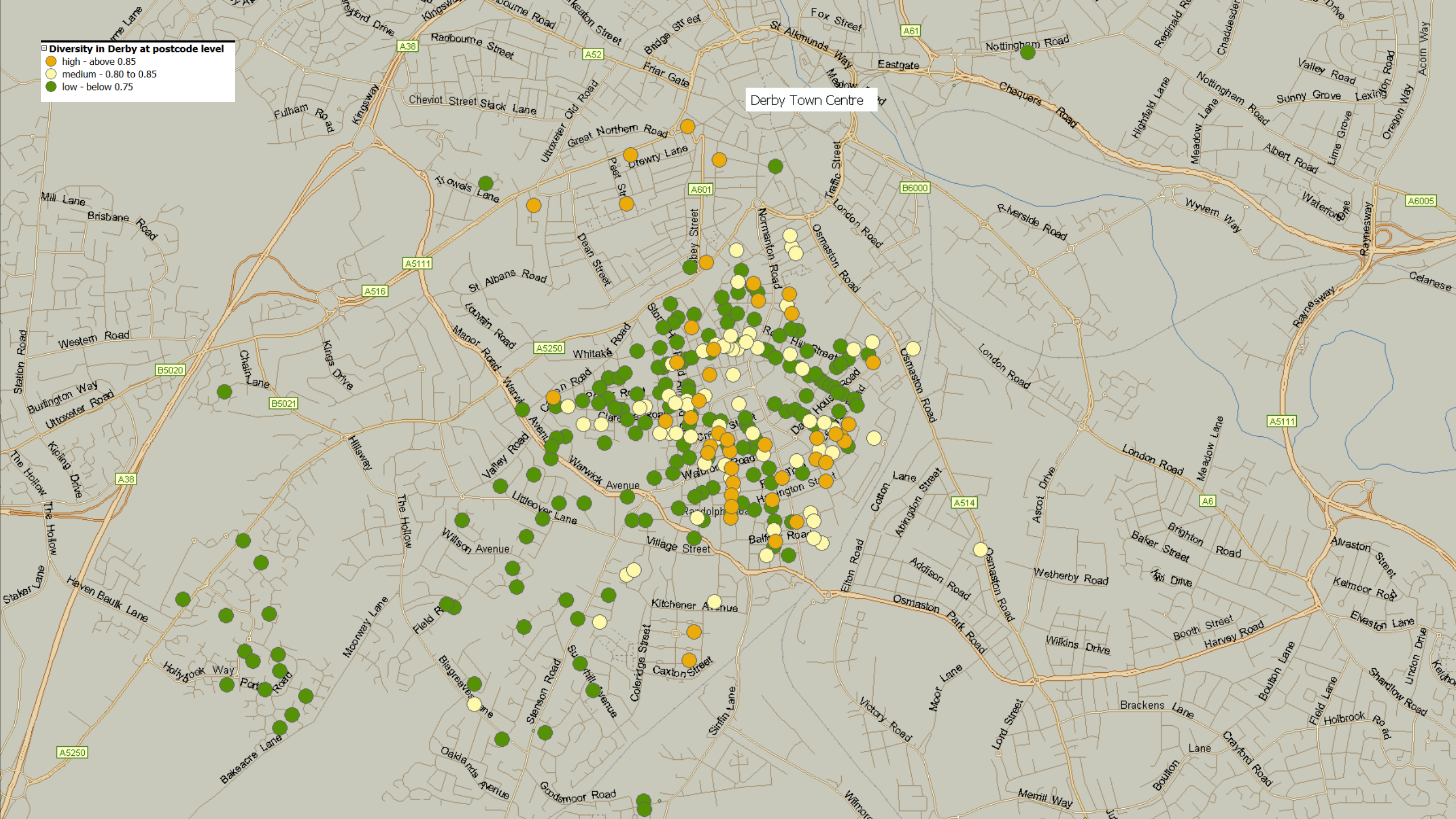


Diversity in Derby at postcode level

- high - above 0.85
- medium - 0.80 to 0.85
- low - below 0.75



Explain the pattern of segregation in Derby?

- This map shown in orange the streets of Derby where immigrants from many different countries have created a melting pot
- Similar maps can be made for any town in the United Kingdom
- Green dots indicate streets which have been taken over by individual minorities but where there is not much mixing. In the orange dots different communities have to get along with each other, no single one is dominant
- You can see that most melting pot areas are close to the centre of Derby. The minorities that have moved to the suburbs tend to have settled among their own community in very selected areas
- Data is displayed at the level of individual street (postcode)
